## Once Upon A Time... *Jack and The Beanstalk*

### KEY AREAS OF LEARNING

**As Scientists** we will identify and describe the basic structure of a variety of common flowering plants by exploring our surroundings and observing plants as they grow.

**As Geographers** we will use simple compass directions (North, South, East and West) and locational and directional language to describe the location of features and routes on a map.

**As Design Technologists** we will design and make puppets using a wide range of materials and components.

**As Artists** we will learn about the work of William Morris and Andy Warhol by describing the differences and similarities between their different practises and disciplines. We will make links to our own work to create artwork based around plants and flowers.

#### LITERACY

- Listen and respond appropriately to adults and their peers.
- Give well structured description, explanations and narratives for different purposes.
- Maintain attention and participate actively in collaborative conversations.
- Apply phonic knowledge and skills as the root to decode words.
- Become familiar with key stories and to recognise and join in with predictable phrases.
- Compose a sentence orally before writing it.

#### MATHEMATICS

- Count to and across 100, forwards and backwards from any given number.
- Count, read and begin to write numbers to 100.
- Identify and represent numbers using objects and pictorial representations.
- Identify more than or less than a number.

#### COMPUTING

- Recognise common uses of information technology beyond school and to use it safely and respectfully.

#### PE

- Begin to develop balance, agility and co-ordination through gymnastics.
- Perform sequences using simple movements and patterns.

#### RE

Is everybody special?

- Pupils will talk about their own experiences and feelings.
- Pupils ask and respond sensitively to questions about their own and others' experiences.

#### MUSIC

- Use voices expressively and creatively by singing songs and speaking chants and rhymes.
- Listen with concentration and understanding to a range of high-quality live and recorded music.

#### Inspiration

- A visit to The Story Museum to hear the story of Jack and the Beanstalk.

#### Enrichment

- Local walks to explore different types of plants and trees.
- Growing beans to create our own beanstalks.

#### Global Perspective

- Link work on plants to the Harvest Festival. Learn about how people around the world celebrate this.
