KEY AREAS OF LEARNING

As Scientists we will find out about and describe the basic needs of animals, including humans, for survival (water, food and air) and describe the importance for humans of exercise, eating the right amounts of different types of food.

As Geographers we will identify seasonal and daily weather patterns in the United Kingdom and the location of hot and cold areas of the world in relation to the Equator and the North and South Poles. We will find out why different foods grow in different parts of the world.

As Design Technologists we will use the basic principles of a healthy and varied diet to prepare dishes understand where food comes from.

As Artists we will to use a range of materials creatively to design and make food packaging for the food we have made. We will also develop a wide range of art and design techniques in using colour, texture, shape and space.

LITERACY

- Read accurately by blending the sounds in words that contain the graphemes taught so far, especially recognising alternative sounds for graphemes.
- Write narratives about personal experiences and those of others (real and fictional).
- Learn how to use both familiar and new punctuation correctly, including full stops, capital letters, exclamation marks and question marks.
- Learn how to use expanded noun phrases to describe and specify.

MATHEMATICS

- Count in steps of 2, 3, and 5 from 0, and in tens from any number, forward and backward
- Recognise the place value of each digit in a two-digit number (tens, ones)
- Compare and order numbers from 0 up to 100; use <, > and = signs
- Read and write numbers to at least 100 in numerals and in words.
- Use place value and number facts to solve problems.

COMPUTING

- Create and debug simple programs and use logical reasoning to predict the behaviour of BeeBot and Scratch programmes.
- Use technology safely and respectfully, keeping personal information private; identify where to go for help and support when they have concerns about content or contact on the internet or other online technologies.

PE

- Master basic movements including running, jumping, throwing and catching, as well as developing balance, agility and co-ordination, and begin to apply these in a range of activities.
- Perform dances using simple movement patterns in gymnastics.

RE

- **Leaders**—Moses, Jesus, world leaders, Prime Minister, Head Teacher, ourselves as leaders.

MUSIC

- Use their voices expressively and creatively by singing songs and speaking chants and rhymes.
- Play tuned and detuned instruments musically, including the recorder.
- Listen with concentration and understanding to a range of high-quality live and recorded music.
