## Passport around the world-

**Year 4**

### KEY AREAS OF LEARNING

#### As Geographic researchers we will:

Locate India on the map, identify the major cities and the countries surrounding it.  
Locate where the Equator lies in relation to India with a cross reference to rainforests.  
Look at the different time zones, compare UK and India.  
Identify topographical features including rivers and mountains and coasts- look at how these aspects have changed over time.  
Have a focus on flooding and make a comparison between Oxford and India.

#### As Scientists we will

Describe the simple functions of the basic parts of the digestive system in humans.  
Identify the different types of teeth in humans and their simple functions.  
Construct and interpret a variety of food chains, identifying producers, predators and prey.

#### As Artists and Design Technologists we will:

Look at how we can mix spices and paint to create works of art.  
Look at Rangoli patterns

#### As Historians we will:

Celebrate 100 years of the vote in England, with a focus on how that impacted India and other British colonies .

### LITERACY

Focus on 'Cinnamon' by Neil Gaimon and develop our story telling techniques. Our class text will inspire adventure story writing, character descriptions and imbed the use of year 4 related grammar and punctuation.

Develop a love of reading, reading fluency and comprehension with whole class Guided Reading.

### MATHEMATICS

Add and subtract numbers with up to 4 digits using the formal written methods of column addition and subtraction. Recall multiplication and division facts for multiplication tables up to 12x12 and solve problems around them. Solve simple measure and money problems involving fractions and decimals to two decimal places.

### COMPUTING

Design and write programmes to achieve specific goals, including solving problems. Computing is also embedded across the curriculum.

### PE

This term Amazon class will be swimming. In the last week of term Danube class will start swimming. We will have a focus this term on gymnastics.

### RE

Exploring Christianity and other religions through story telling, discussion and debate.

### MUSIC

Exploring rhythm using a range of different instruments: percussion, wind and drums, with a focus on India.

Speak in sentences, using familiar vocabulary, phrases and basic language structures.
