KEY AREAS OF LEARNING

As Historians we will

Place Ancient Egypt on a historical timeline and understand its relevance to the modern day.
To understand some of the experiences of people in Ancient Egypt.
To find out about the Egyptians from artefacts that are left behind.

As Scientists we will

Categorise materials on their state of matter.
Observe that some materials change state when they are heated or cooled.
Measure or research the temperature at which this happens in degrees Celsius (°C).
Identify the part played by evaporation and condensation in the water cycle and associate the rate of evaporation with temperature.
Investigate the usefulness of different materials and draw conclusions.

As Artists and Design Technologists we will

Take part in creating art inspired by the Roald Dahl project.
Explore Egyptian art using a range of different media.

LITERACY

Explore the works of a significant Author: Roald Dahl.

Develop a love of reading, reading fluency and comprehension.

Class text will inspire writing in a range of genres including: Biographies, instruction writing and monologues.

Vocabulary covered: story; narrative; tale, plot; characters/protagonist; themes. problem,; setting summary.

MATHEMATICS

Developing an understanding of numbers and their place value.

Making cultural and historical references to different number systems.

Making the links between the four operations in the context of problem solving.

COMPUTING

Developing an understanding of algorithms and debugging through the use of the Scratch programme. Computing is also embedded across the curriculum.

PE

Exploring a range of movement skills, including co-ordination and ball skills (throwing and catching). Through cooperative games, we will develop our team spirit.

RE

Exploring Christianity through story telling, discussion and debate.

MUSIC

Exploring rhythm using a range of different instruments: percussion, wind and drums.
