KEY AREAS OF LEARNING

As Scientists we will classify animals into groups and describe how animals obtain their food from plants and other animals, using the idea of a simple food chain, and identify and name different sources of food.

As Geographers we will name and locate the world's seven continents and five oceans. We will use world maps, atlases and globes to identify the United Kingdom and its countries, as well as the countries, continents and oceans. We will use simple compass directions (North, South, East and West) and locational and directional language [for example, near and far; left and right], to describe the location of features and routes on a map.

As Design Technologists we will construct a mask of the big bad wolf.

As Artists we will draw and paint pictures to show LRRH's journey.

LITERACY

- Listen and respond appropriately to adults and their peers.
- Ask relevant questions to extend their understanding and knowledge.
- Read accurately by blending the sounds in words that contain the graphemes taught so far, especially recognising alternative sounds for graphemes.
- Write narratives about personal experiences and those of others (real and fictional).
- Learn how to use both familiar and new punctuation correctly, including full stops, capital letters, exclamation marks and question marks.

MATHEMATICS

- Count in steps of 2, 3, and 5 from 0, and in tens from any number, forward and backward
- Recognise the place value of each digit in a two-digit number (tens, ones)
- Identify, represent and estimate numbers using different representations, including the number line
- Compare and order numbers from 0 up to 100; use <, > and = signs
- Read and write numbers to at least 100 in numerals and in words.
- Use place value and number facts to solve problems.

COMPUTING

- We will use technology purposefully to create, organise, store, manipulate and retrieve digital content, using iPads to find out information about animals. We will recognise common uses of information technology beyond school and use it safely.

PE

- We will participate in team games, developing simple tactics for attacking and defending.

RE
