KEY AREAS OF LEARNING

As Geographers we will
Develop mapping skills
Understand the process of how rivers are formed

As Scientists we will

Describe the simple functions of the basic parts of the digestive system in humans
Identify the different types of teeth in humans and their simple functions

As Artists and Design Technologists we will
Create an island using junk modelling
Design and create a boat to carry 1kilo

LITERACY

Whole class focus on developing a love of reading, broadening vocabulary and an understanding of a variety of different texts.

Inspired by the Story Museum's exhibition 'Ever After'. Children will create their own islands and draw inspiration from these for their writing. Including, letter writing, persuasive writing and report writing.

MATHEMATICS

Drawing what we learnt about the four operations, we will apply this to a range of problems involving fractions, time, money and shape.

We will continue to develop children's number sense and their ability to manipulate numbers to solve problems using the concrete, pictorial and abstract approach (CPA).

COMPUTING

Continue to develop an understanding of algorithms and debugging through the use of the Scratch programme and Code.org. Computing is also embedded across the curriculum, through programmes such as 'Book Creator'.

PE

Children will explore different types of dance and have the opportunity to choreograph their own routines. Children will also continue with the 'Daily Mile' to increase stamina and concentration.

RE

To explore teachings and authority within Christianity and Hinduism.

MUSIC

Developing knowledge of pitch, rhythm and tone. Children will showcase their skills in a performance.

FRENCH

Explore and investigate French cuisine through speaking, listening and writing with an emphasis on games and music.
