As Artists we will:

Improve their mastery of art and design techniques, including drawing, painting and sculpture with a range of mediums.

As designers we will:

understand and apply the principles of a healthy and varied diet
prepare and cook a variety of predominantly savoury dishes using a range of cooking techniques
understand seasonality, and know where and how a variety of ingredients are grown, reared, caught and processed.

LITERACY

Fictional narratives will remain an ongoing focus throughout the year. Persuasive letters, diary entries, leaflets and instruction writing will provide a focus for our non fiction writing.

MATHEMATICS

Initially we will focus on preparation towards SATs.

Post SATs the curriculum explores nets, statistics, 3D shape and mathematical investigation.

Computing is also embedded across the curriculum.
