### Year 1: Liffey and Congo

#### Inquiry Question and summary of project

#### *How do stories shape what we think?*

Children will be working as 'Dragonologists' in order to find out about different dragons. This will challenge their preconceived ideas, that dragons are scary and dangerous.

The children will then be looking at the skills needed to be a story teller. They will use the skills learnt in order to write their own dragon stories.

#### Spelling/Phonics

All children will receive a list of Year 1 high frequency words. Please regularly practise spelling these words.

#### PE

PE lessons are every Monday and Thursday.

Please can children come into school wearing clothes appropriate for sports.

#### Suggestions for support at home

Visit the Story Museum, which is due to re-open on the 4<sup>th</sup> April.

Visit the Ashmolean Museum, specifically looking at the animals diets. This will reinforce the children's learning about herbivores, carnivores and omnivores.

#### Number Facts

We are continuing to develop the children's place value knowledge of numbers up to 50.

They will use this place value knowledge to support their addition and subtraction knowledge.
