Our team mostly consists of Teaching Assistants, most of who you will be familiar with already. Our Activities

After School Club Information

Group Names

We have divided our children in to groups according to their year. We have found that since covid restrictions were put in place, our groups are much smaller therefore more enjoyable. We have decided to continue with this layout, as it has enabled us to provide better structured activities. Both children and parents have informed us, that it is a much calmer environment and the bond between staff and child is stronger.

We have also found that these groupings support the transition from their classrooms to ASC, allowing a handover on how your child's day has been.

Activities

Daily, we provide each child with the option of outdoor and indoor activities. Our ASC Stars have the opportunity to have free choice doing an activity they love, with friends from their group. Our activities consist of child led and adult led activities. These include physical, Arts and Craft and ice breakers, as well as free choice/role play based activities. Where possible, we like to cook, carry out science experiments and dance lots!

Communication

Any messages or queries can be made to clubs@st-ebbes.oxon.sch.uk alternatively, you can contact the school reception.

We kindly ask that you notify us:

- By 2:30pm, If your child isn't attending ASC (E.g. Sickness, early collection or someone else collecting from ASC.)
- Ensure that Arbor records are up to date for Medications/Allergies/ Emergency Contact details.

Photo Permission

During our fun activities, we take photos of our children and their creations for you all to see. We kindly ask you update your photo permissions via Arbor.

Terms and Conditions

All our terms and conditions and policies can be found on the school website. Please familiarise yourselves with these. If you have any queries, please contact the school.

What if my child has an accident whilst at club?

Injury - Your child will be checked over by a trained first aider on site, and accidents will be reported to you upon collection. You will be contacted earlier if your child requires medical attention.

Toileting Accident – Please ensure your child has access to spare clothes with them in their bag. Alternatively, Parents/carers may be called to bring a change of clothing.

Do you provide my child with a drink and snack?

Yes. Children are provided with a nutritious healthy snack with a selection of fruits/vegetables on the side. We ask that parents provide children with a water bottle in school, so we can ensure your child stays hydrated throughout the day.

• My child has allergies/intolerances and may require medication.

We ensure that all staff familiarise themselves with any allergies/ intolerances/preferences that children may have. This includes supporting children with severe allergies and require Epi-pens. We ask parents/carers continuously provide us with up to date changes via Arbor to Medication/ Allergies/ Emergency Contact details.

Do you provide personal support if needed?

We ensure that all children are supported throughout our sessions, and that their needs are met. If your child requires additional support, please ensure you speak with a member of our ASC Team.

• Can my child play with their friend?

We are now able to allow more free play between groups, meaning children can see older/younger siblings or friends. However, we still do have set groups which provide age appropriate activities.

What activities is my child involved in?

We offer a variety of activities which include Sports, Creative, Movement, Cooking, Science and much more. Each activities are adapted to their needs/ development.

Please see our activity boards at main reception to see what child has planned each day/week. At the end of each term, we post all our fun activities in a newsletter for you to browse.
